As such, Samastipur College, being the sole institution of higher education in this socio-economically backward rural area, has been endeavoring for academic up-liftment of people of the locality and this goal and mission of

the college is reflected in various spheres of life. Keeping in view, the goal, Samastipur College has chalked out the following plan of actions for the academic session 2016-17

- 1. The college plans to organize a one day talk on a relevant topic of literature. There is a plan to invite an eminent resource person to deliver the talk which will be quite beneficial to the students and teachers of all the departments.
- 2. The college has planned to organize a workshop on the theme "Examination reform, paper setting and evaluation" and the topic has been regarded as of prime importance of the commencement of various examinations.
- 3. The college has also planned to organize a programme on **AIDS awareness** in collaboration with the Bihar AIDS control Agency.
- 4. The college has also planned to organize a 'Blood donation camp in collaboration with District Health Society.
- 5. There is also a plan to organize another work shop on 'AIDS-causes, and preventions' in collaboration with national Rural Health Mission.
- 6.At the initiative of each and every department of college, class seminars will be organized among student on a regular basis and in addition to this the college will organize a district level seminar on various thrust area.

1. Activities reflecting the goal and objectives of the institution :

To achieve the goal and objectives, the college has undertaken the programmes in three dimensions such as. Teaching, Research and extension activities. In teaching UG and PG courses, Ph D and Research project on various thrust areas in humanities, social science and research oriented activities for dissemination of research based knowledge among students were undertaken. Besides, extension activities like cultural and literary programmes, health and hygiene programmes are also organized.

The college has completed the extension of a new block of Women Hostel with financial assistance from UGC under XI plan and in addition of existing audio-visual teaching aids a set of flat screen TV bigger in size has also been installed in the newly constructed class-room. The Conference Hall has been completed, Library atomized

27. Technology up gradation.

In addition to the existing techno based facilities the college has installed WIMAX, WI FI **Broad-Band communication** net-work to upgrade the internet facility. The college is also endeavoring to install a teleconferencing net-work for class-room teaching.

28. Computer and Internet access and training to teacher and students.

Catering to the needs of teachers and taught the college has provided internet facility at a cheaper rate. Moreover, special training has also been organized for the benefit of teachers and students for computer and internet operation.

29. Financial aid to students:

The college has the provision of student's aid fund and under this programme the poor students were provided text books and other stationary materials. Around 470 students belonging to OBC, MOBC, SC, ST Category have received Rs.12, 87450.00 as scholarship in the academic year 2015- 16 Moreover 15 Nos. of poor students have received Rs. 19200.00 as special financial assistance. Under the procession of "Free scholarship' 7 Nos. of students who received Rs.14210.00, were benefited and in total, an amount of Rs.1108071.00 was spent by the college for that purpose.

30. Activities and support from the Alumni Association;

With the active help and support of **Alumni Association** a flood relief camp was organized on 26th and 27th July 2015 at neighboring village

The members of the Alumni Association actively participated in the **'Street Drama'** organized by the students of the college on 2nd Feb 2015

The College setup A **Women Development Cell** with a Teacher convener to promote women empowerment specially to enhance personality development of girl students.

On the 8th March 2016, 'Women's Day' was observed by Samastipur College with the active participation of the Alumni Association.

31. Activities and support from the Parent Teacher Association.

They suggested:

- 1. To adopt extra tutorial classes for exceptionally meritorious students and remedial classes for poor students of minority communities
- 2. To organize regular career counseling.
- 3. To extend consultancy on Agro-based activities and on social values.

32. Health service:

Under the aegies of college health centre, the college has organized some of the health programmes such as **First-Aid**, AIDS awareness programmes.

33. Performance in sport activities:

The college has always given special emphasis on improvement of Games and Sports. The students have been provided special coaching on foot ball and volley ball on a regular basis. The students have always taken active part in various districts, inter-districts level sports, in the youth festival, inter college competitions of LNM University and brought laurel to the college.

Moreover, annual sports week is organized to encourage the sport man spirit and sense of unity among students.

34. Incentive to outstanding sport persons:

The college has special schemes of incentive to out standing sports persons. In the academic year 2015-16 fifteen students were given admission in sports quota on the basis of their performance in sports. Special coaching was also organized for the college **Volley Ball team**.

Prize and awards were also given to the outstanding sports persons during annual sports week.

35. Student achievement and awards:

Performance of students in academic cultural, literary is some what satisfactory due to some field's oriented programmes being initiated by the college for the students.

Academic: Three students from the department of Botany, Mathematics and Political Science secured 1st position in the university exam of Post graduate classes in 2014 all of them were facilitated by the college administration.

Cultural:

Literary: the College has started to publish a Journal named **Inter-disciplinary Journal** under the auspice of the Dept. of Political Science biannually. The college has also brought out its Magazine named, BHARTI 2016 which is being published for nearly 45 year.

Guidance and counseling cell of the college has taken utmost care to provide up to date information on various employments and career oriented avenues from time to time. The students are provided requested information and guidance for various competitive examinations also.

The Placement Cell is actively engaged in contacting the Tisco, Birla Sun and Reliance Group to visit the college. The students are also motivated to prepare themselves to face the recruiting agencies.

Trainings on operation of newly installed software programmes and skill development in office management were conducted for the non-teaching staff of the college.

The college is still carrying on the practice, of Morning Assembly to inculcate the spiritual values in terms of mental discipline before beginning the college routine activities.

Keeping in view the development of knowledge in reflective level the college organized interdepartmental/interdisciplinary discussion with the active participation of teachers and taught. Moreover, **Quiz competition**, **Debate**, **literary competition**, **Class Magazine and wall Magazine competition** were organized at a regular interval and as a result of these competitions the students were motivated and reinforced to engage themselves to accelerate their competitive capability and as an impact of this best practice, students were inspired to take part in such competitions organized by other academic institutions.

To develop the managerial skills of students, planned academic events are being organized with the active co-operation of students. In addition to that, the students are also engaged in self-monitoring mechanism by representative way for controlling situations pertaing to students.

In order to raise students prospects, the college has organized some events such as regular career counseling, psycho-based counseling, talk on specific discipline viz. Humanities and social Science, campus interview, programme on investment policy, programmes on personality development etc. In support of student's facilities like material condition of teaching, facilities for extracurricular activities viz games and sports materials musical instruments are provided for developing potentialities of students and as a result of these best practices students bagged desired laurels.
